



Job Description

Position: Clinician/Social Worker – full time

Reports to: Youth Services/Family Alliance Program Coordinator/Clinical Supervisor/ED

Family Alliance Clinician Responsibilities:

- Participate in weekly group clinical supervision/treatment meeting.
- Participate in weekly individual supervision with clinical supervisor.
- Conduct a psycho-social assessment for families.
- Provide in home counseling.
- Work towards goals for family as stated by DCF and Family Networks.
- Make timely and necessary referrals for families.
- Meet a minimum of once a week in the home, more if the family is in crisis.
- Attend family meetings and maintain weekly contact with DCF and Family Networks.
- Create and enter treatment plans and progress reviews on Virtual Gateway.
- Maintain current progress notes.
- Participate in activities in an effort to promote Family Alliance at local DCF offices.
- Attend staff meetings as required.
- Flexible hours to meet the needs of the program.

Other responsibilities:

- Facilitate The Right Moves asset building groups in local elementary schools or community settings.
- Attend staff meetings as required.
- Participate in the development and implementation of program needs assessment and program design process, when required.
- Collect data and document project activities as needed for program evaluation.



Qualifications: Experienced, licensed (or license eligible), MSW or Masters Level Clinician with a degree in the related human service field. The candidate will be assigned primarily to our Family Stabilization Program. This Clinician must have had prior experience working with at-risk populations. Focus of attention will be upon home visits, assessments, providing clinical therapy to challenged clients and submitting reports and documentation.
